

# Entry-Level Police Officer Hiring Process

### All applicants must meet the following minimum requirements established by the City of Kankakee:

- U.S. citizenship;
- No felony convictions;
- Valid Illinois-issued driver's license;
- Must be between 20 and 35 years of age (must be 21 years of age at time of appointment), unless otherwise exempt per state statute;
- Associates Degree or 60 college credit hours
- College credit may be substituted with proof of two consecutive years of active duty military service or 180 consecutive days served in a combat zone.
- Must successfully complete a written examination, oral interview and physical agility test (P.O.W.E.R. Test);
- Must successfully complete a background investigation, polygraph, psychological and medical testing;
- **Pay a \$45.00 non-refundable application processing fee.**

**Preference Points will be awarded for Military Experience:** 5 points for 1 year of active duty U.S. military service members with an Honorable Discharge. Form DD-214 must be submitted with application to qualify.
