All applicants must meet the following minimum requirements established by the City of Kankakee:

- U.S. citizenship;
- No felony convictions;
- Valid Illinois-issued driver's license;
- Must be between 20 and 35 years of age (must be 21 years of age at time of appointment), unless otherwise exempt per state statute;
- High school graduate or GED equivalent;
- Must successfully complete a written examination, oral interview and physical agility test (P.O.W.E.R. Test);
- Must successfully complete a background investigation, polygraph, psychological and medical testing;
- **Pay a \$45.00 non-refundable application processing fee.**

Submission of Application:

Applications **MUST** be submitted online by **Friday, October 14, 2016 at 4:00 PM (CST)**. Faxed, e-mailed, mailed or dropped off applications will **NOT** be accepted. Applications submitted after the deadline will **NOT** be accepted. Only one application per person, per testing cycle will be accepted.

Preference Points will be awarded for Military Experience: 5 points for 1 year of active duty U.S. military service members with an Honorable Discharge. Form DD-214 must be submitted with application to qualify.
